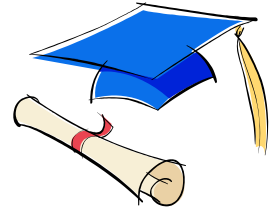


Hoodview Amateur Radio Club

Annual Scholarship

The purpose of the Hoodview Amateur Radio Club Scholarship is to provide one student of excellence and need with a \$500 scholarship to be used for tuition, fees or books. No cash will be disbursed.



Scholarship will be awarded each Fall Term. If the scholarship is not awarded fall term it will be reopened winter term and if it is not awarded winter term it will be reopened spring term.

THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a registered MHCC student carrying a minimum of 12 credit hours during each term the scholarship is in effect.
- Be a licensed radio amateur or the immediate family member of a licensed radio amateur (i.e. parent, sibling, and grandparent). Submit appropriate documents.
- Have a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA. High school applicants must submit a copy of grade transcripts with their application.
- Demonstrate financial need for scholarship aid.
- Submit two letters of recommendation in support of the scholarship application and a brief statement outlining student's goals.

TIMELINE:

Fall Term – Scholarship is announced by the Financial Aid Office at the beginning of spring term for the following fall term. Applicant(s) will be screened by Financial Aid and referred to MHCC Foundation Scholarship Committee. The committee, along with input from MHCC staff and/or the donor, will select the winner.

If the scholarship is not awarded fall term, it will be reopened each term until awarded.
